MASSAGE PROGRAMS

Therapeutic Massage Training Program Day

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Therapeutic Massage Training Program (32-week Day Program) is 93%. The employment rate is 62%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is April 1, 2015 through March 31, 2016. In this timeframe, 42 students started and, of those, 39 (93%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 39 students, 2 students pursued further education and 23 (62%) students obtained training related employment.

Therapeutic Massage Training Program Evening

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Therapeutic Massage Training Program (52-week Evening Program) is 79%. The employment rate is 71%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2015. In this timeframe, 57 students started and, of those, 45 (79%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 45 students, 32 (71%) students obtained training related employment.

Advanced Therapeutic Massage Training Program Day

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Advanced Therapeutic Massage Training Program (44-week Day Program) is 100%. The employment rate is 100%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015. In this timeframe, 6 students started and, of those, 6 (100%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 6 students, 6 (100%) students obtained training related employment.

Advanced Therapeutic Massage Training Program Evening

Graduation and employment rates were not reported to ACCSC because no students were enrolled in the program during ACCSC's reporting period.

SKIN CARE PROGRAMS

Skin Care Training Program Day

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Skin Care Training Program (22-week Day Program) is 86%. The employment rate is 74%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is September 1, 2015 through August 31, 2016. In this timeframe, 42 students started and, of those, 36 (86%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 36 students, 1 student was unavailable for employment and 26 (74%) students obtained training related employment.

Skin Care Training Program Evening

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Skin Care Training Program (22-week Evening Program) is 91%. The employment rate is 78%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is September 1, 2015 through August 31, 2016. In this timeframe, 11 students started and, of those, 10 (91%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 10 students, 1 student pursued further education and 7 (78%) students obtained training related employment.

Makeup Artistry & Skin Care Program Day

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Advanced Paramedical Skin Care Program (52-week Evening Program) is 67%. The employment rate is 79%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is June 1, 2015 through May 31, 2016. In this timeframe, 21 students started and, of those, 14 (67%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 14 students, 11 (79%) students obtained training related employment.

Makeup Artistry & Skin Care Program Evening

Graduation and employment rates were not reported to ACCSC because no students were enrolled in the program during ACCSC's reporting period.

Advanced Paramedical Skin Care Program Day

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Advanced Paramedical Skin Care Program (62-week Day Program) is 65%. The employment rate is 87%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is June 1, 2014 through May 31, 2015. In this timeframe, 23 students started and, of those, 15 (65%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 15 students, 13 (87%) students obtained training related employment.

Advanced Paramedical Skin Care Program Evening

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Advanced Paramedical Skin Care Program (67-week Evening Program) is 71%. The employment rate is 100%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is April 1, 2014 through March 31, 2015. In this timeframe, 7 students started and, of those, 5 (71%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 5 students, 1 student was unavailable for employment and 4 (100%) students obtained training related employment.

AS PROGRAMS

AS Degree in Natural Health Concentration in Advanced Paramedical Skin Care Day

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the AS Degree in Natural Health Concentration Advanced Paramedical Skin Care Program (81-week Day Program) is 100%. The employment rate is not applicable. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is December 1, 2013 through November 30, 2014. In this timeframe, 1 students started and 1 (100%) students graduated within 150% of the program length. The student was unavailable for employment, and therefore the placement rate is not applicable.
