MESSAGE PROGRAMS

Professional Massage Training Program Day

The completion rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Professional Massage Therapy Program (22-week Day Program) is 83%. The placement rate is 72%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016. In this timeframe, 99 students started and, of those, 82 (83%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 82 students, 8 students were unavailable for employment, and 53 (72%) students obtained training related employment.

Professional Massage Training Program Evening

The completion rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Professional Massage Therapy Program (42-week Evening Program) is 77%. The placement rate is 45%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2015. In this timeframe, 43 students started and, of those, 33 (77%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 33 students, 1 student was unavailable for employment, 1 student pursued further education, and 14 (45%) students obtained training related employment.

Extended Professional Massage Training Program Day

The completion rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Extended Professional Massage Therapy Program (42-week Day Program) is 83%. The placement rate is 76%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2016. In this timeframe, 59 students started and, of those, 49 (83%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 49 students, 37 (76%) students obtained training related employment.

Extended Professional Massage Training Program Evening

The completion rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Extended Professional Massage Therapy Program (72-week Evening Program) is 80%. The placement rate is 80%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is March 1, 2014 through February 28, 2015. In this timeframe, 25 students started and, of those, 20 (80%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 20 students, 16 (80%) students obtained training related employment.
