MASSAGE PROGRAMS

Therapeutic Massage Training Program Day

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Therapeutic Massage Training Program (32-week Day Program) is 72%. The employment rate is 55%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is April 1, 2015 through March 31, 2016. In this timeframe, 33 students started and, of those, 23 (72%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 23 students, 1 student pursued further education, 2 students were unavailable for employment, and 11 (70%) students obtained training related employment.

Therapeutic Massage Training Program Evening

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Therapeutic Massage Training Program (52-week Evening Program) is 56%. The employment rate is 28%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2015. In this timeframe, 36 students started and, of those, 20 (56%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 20 students, 2 students were unavailable for employment, and 5 (28%) students obtained training related employment.

Advanced Therapeutic Massage Training Program Day

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Advanced Therapeutic Massage Training Program (44-week Day Program) is 90%. The employment rate is 88%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015. In this timeframe, 20 students started and, of those, 18 (90%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 18 students, 1 student pursued further education and 15 (88%) students obtained training related employment.

SKIN CARE PROGRAMS

Skin Care Training Program Day

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Skin Care Training Program (22-week Day Program) is 100%. The employment rate is 75%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is September 1, 2015 through August 31, 2016. In this timeframe, 27 students started and, of those, 27 (100%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 27 students, 3 students pursued further education, and 18 (75%) students obtained training related employment.

Skin Care Training Program Evening

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Skin Care Training Program (22-week Evening Program) is 78%. The employment rate is 75%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is September 1, 2015 through August 31, 2016. In this timeframe, 9 students started and, of those, 7 (78%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 7 students, 2 students pursued further education, 1 student was unavailable for employment, and 3 (75%) students obtained training related employment.

Makeup Artistry & Skin Care Program Day

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Makeup Artistry & Skin Care Program (32-week Day Program) is 80%. The employment rate is 71%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is June 1, 2015 through May 31, 2016. In this timeframe, 25 students started and, of those, 20 (80%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 20 students, 3 students pursued further education, and 12 (71%) students obtained training related employment.

Makeup Artistry & Skin Care Program Evening

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Professional Massage Therapy Program (32-week Evening Program) is 20%. The employment rate is 100%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2016. In this timeframe, 5 students started and, of those, 1 (20%) graduated within 150% of the program length. The 1 student (100%) obtained training related employment.

Advanced Paramedical Skin Care Program Day

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Advanced Paramedical Skin Care Program (62-week Day Program) is 37%. The employment rate is 67%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is June 1, 2014 through May 31, 2015. In this timeframe, 29 students started and, of those, 10 (37%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 10 students, 6 (67%) students obtained training related employment.

AS PROGRAMS

AS Degree in Natural Health Concentration in Advanced Therapeutic Massage Day

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the AS Degree in Natural Health Concentration in Advanced Therapeutic Massage (71-week Day Program) is 100%. The employment rate is 67%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is March 1, 2014 through February 28, 2015. In this timeframe, 3 students started and, of those, 3 (100%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 3 students, 2 (67%) students obtained training related employment.

AS Degree in Natural Health Concentration in Massage Therapy and Skin Care Day

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the AS Degree in Natural Health Concentration in Massage Therapy & Skin Care Program (71-week Day Program) is 100%. The employment rate is 100%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is March 1, 2014 through February 28, 2015. In this timeframe, 2 students started and, of those, 2 (100%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Both students (100%) obtained training related employment.

AS Degree in Natural Health Concentration in Massage Therapy and Skin Care Evening

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the AS Degree in Natural Health Concentration in Massage Therapy & Skin Care Program (111-week Evening Program) is 100%. The employment rate is 50%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is March 1, 2014 through February 28, 2015. In this timeframe, 2 students started and, of those, 2 (100%) graduated within 150% of the program length. One student (50%) obtained training related employment.
