MESSAGE PROGRAMS

Professional Massage Therapy Program Day

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Professional Massage Therapy Program (32-week Day Program) is 75%. The employment rate is 78%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is April 1, 2015 through March 31, 2016. In this timeframe, 126 students started and, of those, 94 (75%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 94 students, 2 students pursued further education, and 72 (78%) students obtained training related employment.

Professional Massage Therapy Program Evening

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Professional Massage Therapy Program (52-week Evening Program) is 77%. The employment rate is 71%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2015. In this timeframe, 59 students started and, of those, 44 (77%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 44 students, 2 students pursued further education, and 30 (71%) students obtained training related employment.
