MESSAGE PROGRAMS

Professional Massage Therapy Program Day

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Professional Massage Therapy Program (32-week Day Program) is 75%. The employment rate is 70%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is April 1, 2015 through March 31, 2016. In this timeframe, 67 students started and, of those, 50 (75%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 67 students, 1 students pursued further education, 3 students were unavailable for employment, and 32 (70%) students obtained training related employment.

Professional Massage Therapy Program Evening

The graduation rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Professional Massage Therapy Program (52-week Evening Program) is 67%. The employment rate is 70%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2015. In this timeframe, 60 students started and, of those, 40 (67%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 40 students, 28 (70%) students obtained training related employment.

Extended Professional Massage Training Program Day

The completion rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Extended Professional Massage Therapy Program (42-week Day Program) is 100%. The placement rate is 85%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015. In this timeframe, 20 students started and, of those, 20 (100%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 20 students, 17 (85%) students obtained training related employment.

Extended Professional Massage Training Program Evening

The completion rate reported to ACCSC as part of its 2017 Annual Report for the Extended Professional Massage Therapy Program (72-week Evening Program) is 57%. The placement rate is 75%. The reporting timeframe for ACCSC is May 1, 2014 through February 28, 2015. In this timeframe, 7 students started and, of those, 4 (57%) graduated within 150% of the program length. Of the 4 students, 3 (75%) students obtained training related employment.
